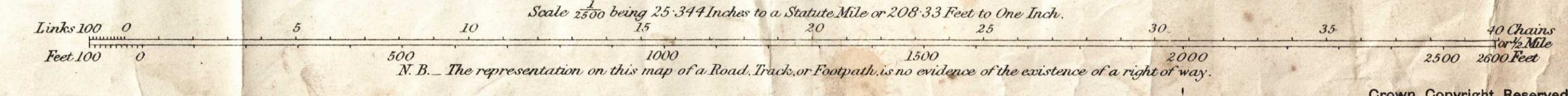

Altitudes indicated thus (B.M. 547) refer to Bench Marks on Buildings, Walls, &c. those marked thus (52 1/2) to surface level.  
Note - To convert Decimal parts of an Acre into Roods and Perches, multiply by 4; this will give Roods and Decimals of a Rood, multiply the Decimal by 40 thus obtaining Perches and Decimals of a Perch. Example - .357 = 1 Rood 17 1/2 Perches
