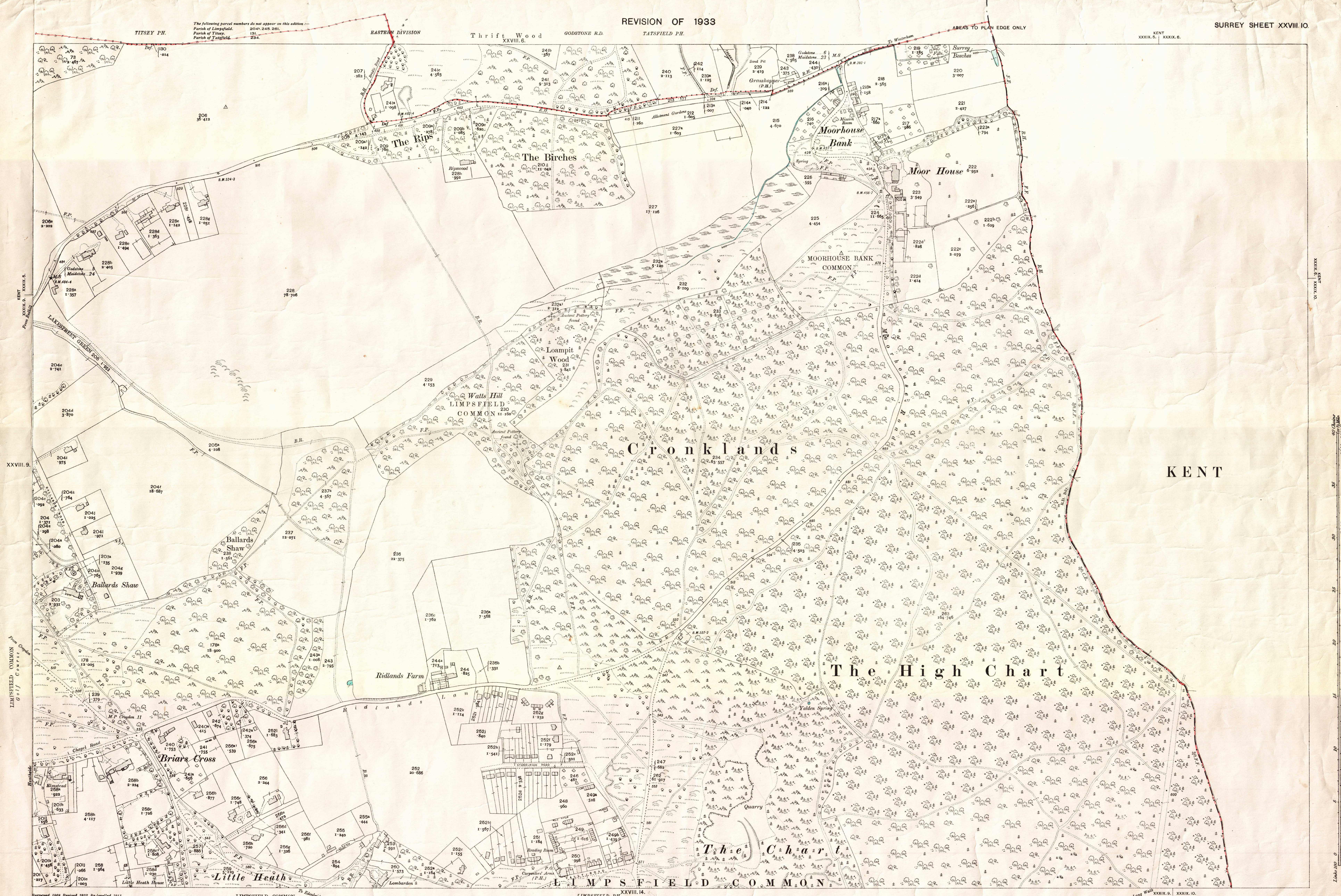

Boroughs	P	Urban Districts	D	Antiquities (Site of)	Its area is given underneath in acres, thus: 4 370
	M	Rural Districts	R	Trigonometrical Station	Brown indicating that the space so connected are included in the same reference number and area

Altitudes indicated thus (B.M. 547) refer to Bench Marks on Buildings, Walls, &c. those marked thus (152) to surface levels. Note: To convert Decimal parts of an Acre into Roods and Perches, multiply by 4, this will give Roods and Decimals of a Rood, multiply this Decimal by 40 thus obtaining Perches and Decimals of a Perch. Example: 357 = 1 Rood 17/20 Perches
